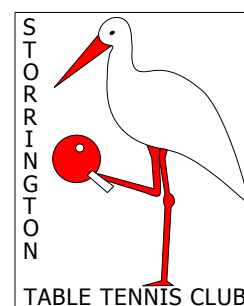


Membership Information

In addition to the above all members have to be a member of Table Tennis England (this annual fee will be collected by the club when you join) it is £16 for adult league players and £8 for junior league players and £0 for and non-league playing juniors and adults.

The club will continue to offer discounts to juniors that pay their whole term session fees in advance.

All current members will receive this notification along with the current stored registration details and the new membership form. The membership form (with the relevant remittance) and the checked, updated and signed registration form have to be returned to the club secretary whose details can be found on the membership form.

¹ If the player joins the club after playing as a non member the difference between the member rate and the non member rate (for a maximum of 2 sessions) will count towards the membership fee.

² If a player comes more that twice as a non-member they have to show proof that they are a Table Tennis England member.

³ Concessions are those on income support, full time students or receiving a state pension.

⁴ Juniors are those under the age of 18 when their membership begins.

⁵ A Coach member is a UKCC qualified coach doing more than 20 hours of unpaid, scheduled coaching during the year.

⁶ A committee member has to have one of the following defined roles Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer, Welfare Officer, Head Coach, Adult Club Officer, Junior Club Officer and League Secretary. If you wish to volunteer for a position contact the Chairperson.
